The Principal MAM College Dr Ajeet Angral kicked off the drive by planting the inaugural sapling.

Speaking on occasion, Angral highlighted the role of youth for the protection & promotion of environment and said, "The deforestation is going to hit hard the very existence of life on this planet. A tree is like a mother in whose lap a child gets peace, love and care."

Sheikh Altaf Hussain, Chairman Global Peace Organization while highlighting the environmental statistics said that within few decades of industrial civilization, the man has destroyed 50 pc of the world's forest and if the present rate of deforestation goes unabated, the world is going to befit a catastrophe by the end of 21st century endangering the whole life on Earth."
