

GREEN POLICY

Context

This green policy will help in instilling environmental ethics among students and the Staff of the College. The policy is a guideline to design co-curricular and extracurricular programmes for promoting environmental friendly practices among students and staff to generate Eco-consciousness among them.

Scope

The key areas of green policy are:

- Clean Campus Initiatives
- Landscaping Initiatives
- Smoking Free Campus
- Installation of Solar Power Plant
- Installation of Energy Efficient Equipment
- Water Conservation through Rainwater Harvesting System
- Restricted entry for automobile
- Pedestrian friendly pathway
- Waste management,
- Cleanliness Awareness programs
- Plantation drives,
- Ban on Single-use Plastics on the Campus etc.

Policy

Clean Campus Initiatives and Landscaping Initiatives are to aware students and the staff of the college to make campus clean. A dedicated staff cleans the campus every. In addition to this various cleanliness and plantation drives are organised by NSS and NCC wings of the college to make campus clean and green. Landscaping of the campus is done by

- Organizing annual tree plantation drives.
- Encouraging students and the staff to hold tree planting events.

Smoking Free Campus: In compliance with the framework provided by the National Tobacco Control Programme (NTCP) 2007-2008, the college prohibits smoking and the use of other tobacco products.

Installation of Solar Power Plant and Energy Efficient Equipment: Maulana Azad Memorial College believes in reducing the consumption of electricity produced by non-renewable resources by switching to clean energy sources like solar energy. As a step toward reducing the burden of power needs of the college on UT power agency, the College has installed solar cell plant on rooftop of the college. The College is also using LEDs and Energy Efficient Equipment.

Water Conservation through Rainwater Harvesting System: Rainwater Harvesting System in the college is helping is replenishing the ground water table.

Restricted entry for automobile and pedestrian friendly pathway: The College has parking area near the main gate of the College. Beyond main gate there are two barriers to restrict entry of the vehicles.

To ensure this the college administration has deployed a security guard and gate keeper. This also helps in making pedestrian –friendly pathways.

Waste management:

 To maintain a clean and green campus has been one of priority areas of Maulana Azad Memorial College, Jammu. The college has adopted Swach Bharat Abhiyan to further make clean and green environment campus. The college has taken several Swachhta initiatives in collaboration with NSS and NCC Unit of the college for waste management.

Solid Waste Management

Different initiatives were taken up by the college to properly manage the various types of waste generated within the campus. Large numbers of dustbins are installed in the campus at different locations of the college for maintaining the cleanliness. Dedicated staffs for hygiene maintenance regularly collect the garbage of the campus and hands over it to the municipal garbage vehicle. The college is also very keen to use of less paper within the campus and for that most of the communication is done through digital media. Notices, order, circulars, are issued electronically through e-mail, WhatsApp groups or on college website. Waste like paper and stationary items are collected regularly and are

disposed through auctions. Students and staff were encouraged to avoid the use of plastic within the campus and various awareness programmes were conducted from time to time for the same. Large numbers of cleanliness drives were also organized with the help of NSS and NCC unit and slogans about cleanliness were also displayed within the campus.

E-waste

• E-waste is more hazardous than any other waste and appropriate steps were taken for the management of the same. Printer cartridges were refilled outside the campus from the authorized agencies and e-waste like inverter batteries were disposed off under buy back options. Defective and unused electronic items were stored properly and authorities have decided to dispose the same through proper e-waste management agency.

Liquid waste

 Liquid waste generated from various laboratories is disposed through the proper drainage system. The college has its own internal drainage systems. It is network of trenches connecting drainage outlets of all Departments and laboratories. It collects liquid waste generated from these Departments and laboratories. The outlet of college internal drainage system is connected to Jammu Municipal Corporation's (JMC) drainage system for further dispose off.

Ban on Single-use Plastics on the Campus: In reference to Plastic Waste Management Amendment Rules issued by Government of India, the use of Single-use Plastics is totally banned in the college premises.
