The proceedings of the event were held by the student Coordinators of this event , Ajay Aryan Sen and Akshit Rana; students of Humanities of Sixth Semester .







ONLINE QUIZ COMPETITION



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DEPARTMENT OF DOGRI

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Dogri is the language of Dogras and they are known to all over the world for their patriotism and art especially Pahari paintings. Dogri is not spoken in Jammu region of Jammu and Kashmir. But it is also spoken in Himachal Pradesh, Punjab (especially in northern parts of Hoshiarpur and Gurdaspur Districts.) and Sialkot and Shakergarh areas of Pakistan. Around one crore of people speaks Dogri languages. It belongs to Indian modern language of Indo- Aryan family of languages. On 22nd of December 2003 this language was included in 8th Schedule of Indian Constitution.

INTERNATIONAL LITERACY DAY



Since 1967, International Literacy Day (ILD) celebrations have taken place annually around the world to remind the public of the importance of literacy as a matter of dignity and human rights, and to advance the literacy agenda towards a more literate and sustainable society. This year's ILD theme is "Literacy for a human-centered recovery: Narrowing the digital divide" white is in sync with this event. 
SPECIAL LECTURE ON DRUG DE-ADDICTION
